He began his judicial service as a Special Judge on January 10, 1983, serving until he was appointed a District Judge on December 26, 1985. He currently serves on the Court on the Judiciary, Appellate Division.

He is a member of the Oklahoma Court Information System (OCIS) Steering Committee. Judge Dixon is a Master and former President of the Bohanon Inn of Court.
