I am a member of the Oklahoma State Medical Association Geriatric Task Force. I coordinated a project addressing “The Role of Attorney Generals to Improve End-of-Life Care,” for Oklahoma Attorney General Edmondson as his Presidential Initiative for the National Association of Attorneys General, 2002-03. For that work I received the NAAG Presidential Award for outstanding contribution to health care. I directed the inpatient mental health units in Oklahoma’s University and Children’s Hospitals. I have served as Adjunct Professor of Contracts, Property and Labor Law for the University of Oklahoma College of Law, Oklahoma City University School of Law, Clinical Assistant Professor, Department of Psychiatry, Oklahoma University Health Sciences, and University of Oklahoma School of Social Work, continuing legal education speaker for the Oklahoma Trial Lawyers Association, the Conference on Consumer Finance Law, Oklahoma Bar Association, and University of Oklahoma Law Center.
